Yara is a Gates Scholar at the University of Cambridge. Originally from Kyiv, Ukraine, she graduated summa cum laude from NYU with a double major in Mathematics and Psychology. With research published in top journals and a speaking invitation from an influential NATO conference, she now studies AI to understand how we can make human-technology interactions more constructive.
